Christ Covenant OPC — Indianapolis, IN -- (Redeemer OPC/Dayton, OH) Pastor Larry Wilson reports that attendance continues to average about 50 for morning worship. Local financial support remains stable but not sufficient to enable the mission to purchase or rent a building that became available that would give Christ Covenant its own meeting place. Christ Covenant rents a Seventh Day Adventist building for Sunday worship and education time. Please pray that God would add to their numbers and strengthen their finances even more. Pastor Larry also reports that others are rolling up their sleeves and helping in some of the work. Pray that the group would continue to grow as a body. Pray that God will gather the people of his choice in to CCOPC and knit them together in faith, hope, and love.

Trinity OPC — Huntington, WV -- (Grace OPC/Columbus, OH) Boone Leigh reports that attendance in their small building has been consistently around the 30 mark. The mission has been in the process of looking for another larger meeting location with better parking and access. God has answered that prayer and Trinity OPC will be moving just around the corner from its present location to a building with better visibility, more room for worship, more class space, and better office space. There will also be a parking lot and on street parking too. Boone has also been more and more involved in counseling struggling believers. Please pray for God bring deeper spiritual and greater numerical growth. Pray that God will give wisdom to Boone as he ministers. We praise God that Boone completed his licensure exams for the Presbytery of Ohio. He is now studying for ordination exams that will be upcoming. Pray that God will bless this time of demanding study and ministry.



Cleveland, Ohio – (Covenant OPC/Mansfield, OH)

This past quarter has seen the group involved in many opportunities of outreach. While God has yet withheld the blessing of additional committed families several solid contacts have been made and the group is seeking ways to minister to them. Pray that God

Lafayette, IN – (Christ Covenant OPC/Sheridan, IN)
